







Adult Class at the Anchor Point Annex.

Guardian of Ninja and Samurai Arts Grandmaster Hatsumi Masaaki Turns 92!

Born on December 2nd, 1931, Hatsumi-Sensei was an expert in many Japanese martial arts when he met Takamatsu-Sensei a recognized master of the Ninja and Samurai Arts. Hatsumi became *Soke* (Grandmaster) after Takamatsu-Sensei's death. He brought these ancient arts to the modern world and founded the *Bujinkan. Bujinkan Budo-Taijutsu* is the art we study and we are grateful to the Grandmaster for allowing us to benefit from the wisdom of this Samurai and Ninja traditions. *Happy Birthday Soke!*
