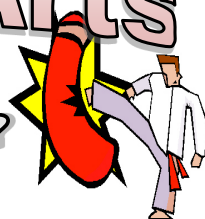

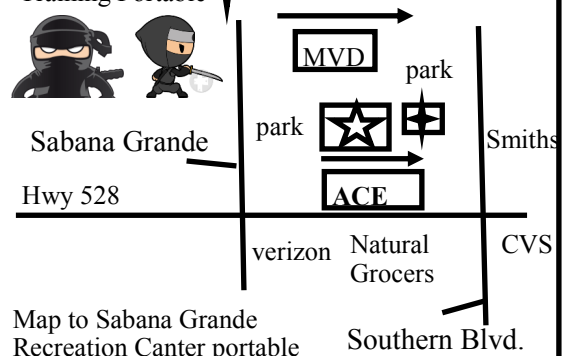

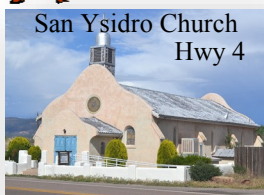


Map to Sabana Grande Recreation Center portable
